This list is effective for cases diagnosed January 1, 2014 to September 30, 2014. There will be a new casefinding list distributed over the summer of 2014 that will be required for casefinding on and after October 1, 2014.

This list is provided at this time to assist you in your casefinding activities in early 2014. Volume I will be updated with these lists in the 2014 version release, currently expected for April 1, 2014.

Updates to ICD-O-3

In September 2011, the International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) and the World Health Organization (WHO) released the document, Updates to the International Classification of Diseases for Oncology, third edition (ICDO-3). Although that document indicated that the changes were valid January 1, 2012, the Cancer Registration Steering Committee (CRSC) in North America recommended that the updates not be incorporated by NAACCR member registries until the impact of these changes could be evaluated.

CRSC requested that NAACCR create a work group to determine how and when the ICD-O-3 changes should be implemented by NAACCR member registries. The Work Group forwarded their implementation recommendations to the NAACCR Change Management Board (CMB) in June 2013. The recommendations were reviewed and accepted.

Please note, the World Health Organization (WHO) and SEER have required that registries recode the following conditions as shown.

- Recode all cases of enteroglucagonoma, NOS, as 8152/1.
 Then delete code 8157/1 Enteroglucagonoma, NOS.
 Enteroglucagonoma is now a related term for glucagonoma.
- Recode all cases of enteroglucagonoma, malignant, as 8152/3. Then delete code 8157/3 Enteroglucagonoma, malignant.

Analysis of the California Cancer Registry data base (Eureka) demonstrated no cases in the data base matching the histology 8157/1 or 8157/3. If your hospital's registry data base contains these codes for your collection purposes, please be advised of these changes, as you may want to consider making these
