



Quality Control Unit Data Memorandum Alert - Registrar 2019-03 - Obsolete Reportability Updates: Cases Diagnosed 1/1/2018 - 12/31/2020

In addition to the diagnoses already published in Volume I, II.1.1 Reportability Guide, the following items will be updated and published in the next release scheduled for spring 2018.

Reportable:

Noninvasive low grade (Micropapillary) serous carcinoma (MPSC) of ovary.

Notes:

- Assign code 8460/2, applying the ICD-O-3 matrix concept to this non-invasive carcinoma.
- Noninvasive can be used as a synonym for in-situ, ICD-O-3 behavior code /2. See page 66 in ICD-O-3.
- Thymoma is reportable when it is documented as NOS with multiple foci, lymph node involvement, or metastasis.

Not Reportable:

 Early or evolving melanoma of any type is NOT reportable, dx 01/01/2018 +

Note: This includes both invasive and in situ melanomas; early or evolving are not reportable.

• Squamous intraepithelial neoplasia III (8077) arising in the perianal skin (C445) is an exception to the skin reportability.
