Commission on Cancer (CoC) - Changes to Registry Follow-Up 1988-2004 Information No Longer Required

The California Cancer Registry (CCR) has performed analysis on patient follow-up data and supports the Commission on Cancer in their decision to no longer require follow-up information on cases diagnosed between 1988 to 2004 for CoC accredited facilities.

NOTE: CCR follow-up requirements **have not changed** as the CCR currently does not impose CA specific follow-up requirements.
