**II.1 CCR Reportability Guide-Reportable**

- ✓ **Liver (C220)**
  - Updated instructions for assignment of Date of Diagnosis based on LI-RADS category.
  - If reportable, per CCR/SEER use the date of the imaging procedure as the date of diagnosis when this is the earliest date and there is no information to dispute the imaging findings.
  - Reference Appendix E1 in the 2023/2024 SEER Program Manual which lists the LI-RADS that are reportable vs non reportable.
- ✓ **Prostate (C619)**
  - Updated instructions for assignment of Date of Diagnosis based on PI-RADS category.
  - If reportable, per CCR/SEER use the date of the imaging procedure as the date of diagnosis when this is the earliest date, and there is no information to dispute the imaging findings.
  - Reference SEER Appendix E1 in the 2023/2024 SEER Program Manual for Reportable Examples.
- ✓ Added statement about Standard Setter Difference to both sections above:
 

**Standard Setter Difference:**

  - The CoC/STORE manual may have different rules on reportability and/or assignment of Date of Diagnosis for Liver and Prostate cases based on LI-RADS OR PI-RADS categories. However, the CCR and SEER rules take precedence in Reporting and assignment of Date of Diagnosis.
