Timeliness Extension for 2025 Cases

As of November 2025, the California Cancer Registry (CCR) has approved all software vendors for the transmission of records with a 2025 Date of Diagnosis. To allow facilities sufficient time to prepare for reinstatement, the CCR timeliness requirements for **cases diagnosed in 2025** are suspended through February 2026. This suspension applies to all reporting facilities, and the Hospital Completeness and Timeliness Report will be retroactively corrected to reflect this change.

Timeliness requirements will resume on March 1, 2026.

- Cases diagnosed in 2025, with first contact between January 1 and August 31, 2025, and received by March 1, 2026, that do not meet the “On Time” timeliness standard (within 6 months) will be excluded from CCR timeliness requirements.
- All other cases are subject to the CCR Timeliness Standard, as outlined in [Volume I: Timeliness and Quality Control](#).

Reminder: Cases first seen in 2024 must still be submitted and received within 6 months of date of first contact.
